



Joseph Howland Scholarships

Two Joseph Howland Scholarships, in the amount of \$1,000 each, are available to be presented at the annual FDEA conference.

The following criteria must be met by each applicant:

- Attends a college with an FDEA institutional membership. (Information available on the FDEA website www.myfdea.net)
- Has successfully completed one developmental math course and one other developmental course either in writing or in reading.
- Has six semester hours of mainstream college level course work (AA/AS).
- Has achieved an overall 3.0 grade point average for all course work.

The following documents must be included in the application packet:

- This scholarship application.
- Up-to-date official college transcript.
- Two letters of recommendation (one from an instructor of a college prep/vocational prep course and one from an instructor of a college level course).
- Typed essay (500 -750 words) describing how the developmental mathematics or developmental writing course has influenced your life. The essay should be typed double spaced as a Word document in size 12 font.
- Photograph or photo file in jpg format and signed release at the bottom of this page.
